## Itinerary

---

### Day1:

Arrive at Canyonlands Field Airport. Transportation will be provided from the airport to our group meeting point. Once at the campsite your guide will go over training and safety procedures for the following day. That evening dinner will be served and afterwards anyone who is interested can participate in an evening hike through Slickrock. There will also be activities so everyone can get better acquainted with one another.

### Day2:

Breakfast will be served at 8:00 am. After breakfast everyone will be transported from our campsite to Wall street where you'll meet with your guide to go over rock climbing procedures. We will stop for lunch at noon and then resume climbing at 1:00 pm. Around 5:00pm we will conclude climbing for the day and head back to camp where dinner and showers will be waiting.

### Day3:

After breakfast we will begin the Slickrock trail for the toughest of the three days - a 13 mile roller coaster ride on wheels! If you've ever heard about mountain biking trails in Moab, this is the

granddaddy of them all! Some of the spots on this trail can be very steep, so don't be afraid to jump off and walk certain portions. Around noon, we will stop for lunch. After lunch, we will finish up and transport everyone back to the campsite where showers, beverages, and snacks will be ready and waiting. That night, dinner will be served and activities will be provided.

### Day4:

Breakfast will be served at 8:00 am. After breakfast we'll make our way to Plaedies canyon where you'll encounter a series of rappels that seem to just keep going. You'll be surrounded by waterfalls, beautiful emerald green mosses and water worn rocks and boulders, weaving your way through numerous water chutes. The water in Plaedies canyon is spring fed, so the water is always cold. We'll make sure to provide you with a drysuit because you'll be wading through plenty of chilly water during the day. We will stop for lunch at noon and then resume canyoneering at 1:00 pm. At 5:00pm we will conclude for the day and head back to camp where dinner and showers will be waiting.

### Day5:

After breakfast, we will pack up camp and transport everyone back to the airport for their return home.
